- Joseph Hernandez Hall — Part of UF's College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, this beautiful, six-level chemistry building is a 111,552-square-foot wonderland for researchers, students and staff.
- UF Data Center — This 25,000-square-foot facility houses HiPerGator, the state's most powerful supercomputer that helps researchers find lifesaving drugs, make decades-long weather forecasts, improve armor for troops and so much more.
- The George T. Harrell, M.D., Medical Education Building — This 95,000-square-foot space provides a dynamic environment for all researchers and learners as they hone the skills necessary to respond to society's changing health care landscape.

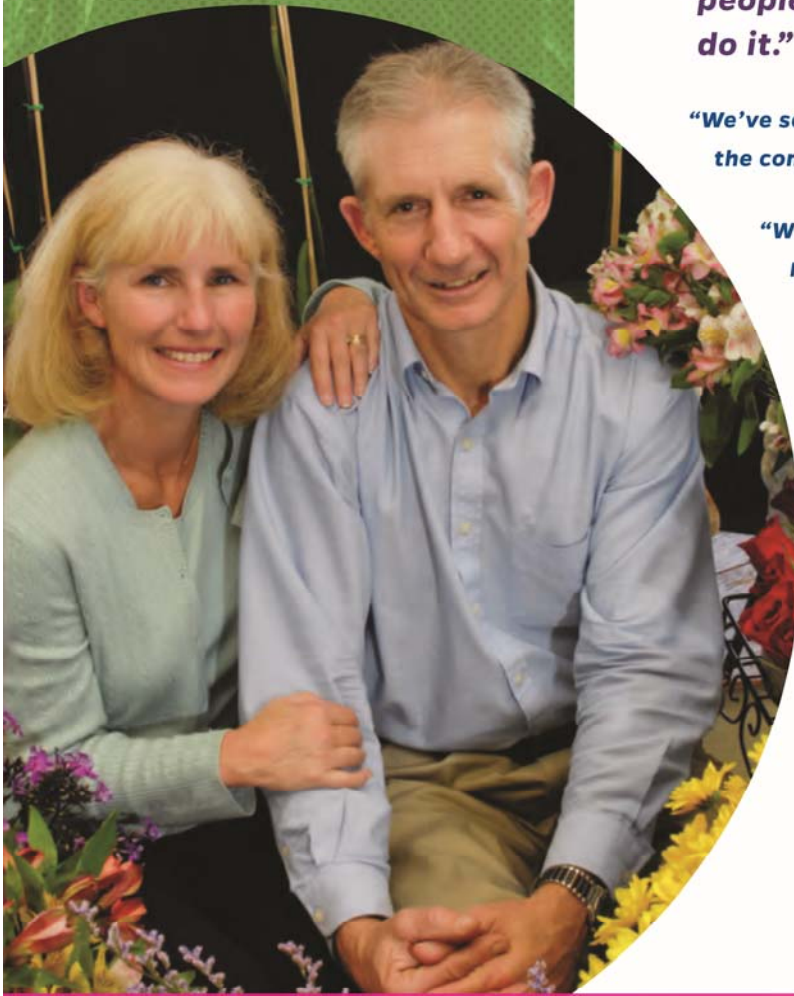
